The recyclable mono-materials in this product line are suitable for a wide range of packaging concepts – such as PE flow-packs for cuts of cheese or garlic baguettes, convenient PP doypacks for snacks, PP or PE block-bottom pouches for coffee, and PP spouted pouches for fruit purées.
